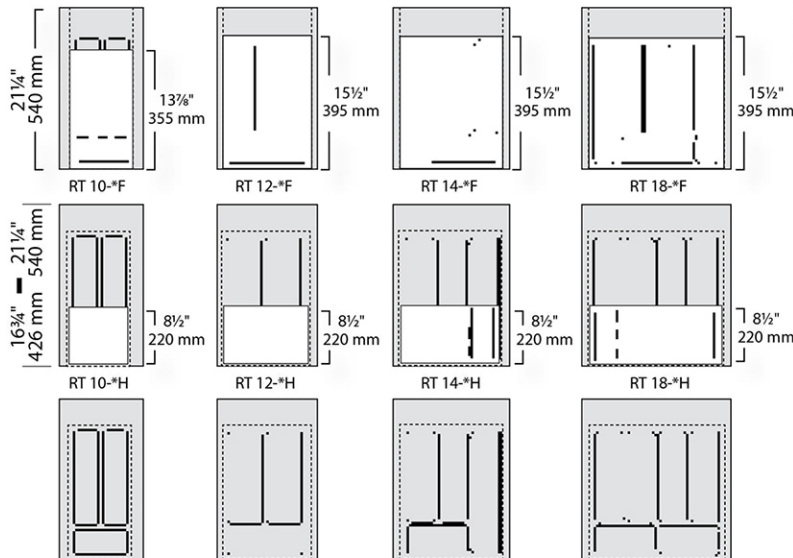
- Our "Patent Pending" Roller System rolls smoothly in a lower tray track built into the Utility Tray & provides a retaining means.
- The top rolling tray requires no trimming and is easily removable from the drawer for convenient consumer use.
- All trays are glossy white in color.

Back of drawer box must be cut down to allow the top tray to roll back. (See drawer box modification specs)

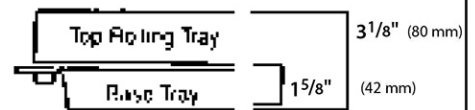

RT-14-*F	17¾" x 21¼" (450 mm x 540 mm)	14¾" x 21¼" (375 mm x 540 mm)
RT-18-*F	21¾" x 21¼" (555 mm x 540 mm)	17¾" x 21¼" (450 mm x 540 mm)

NOTE: BOTTOM TRAY MUST BE CUT TO FIT DRAWER WIDTH ONLY. DO NOT TRIM LENGTH OF BOTTOM TRAY AS IT RETAINS THE TOP ROLLING TRAY.



SHALLOW SYSTEM

Requires 3⅞" min. clearance
Base Tray is 1⅝" Deep



NOTES:

- All Utility Trays are trimmable to 16¾" (426 mm) depth. For the Full Cutlery Tray Systems to provide adequate accessibility to the utensils in the lower tray, a portion of the drawer back must be removed. No depth trimming of the lower utility tray will be necessary.
- Minimum height refers to the cabinet drawer opening, not just the height of the drawer.
