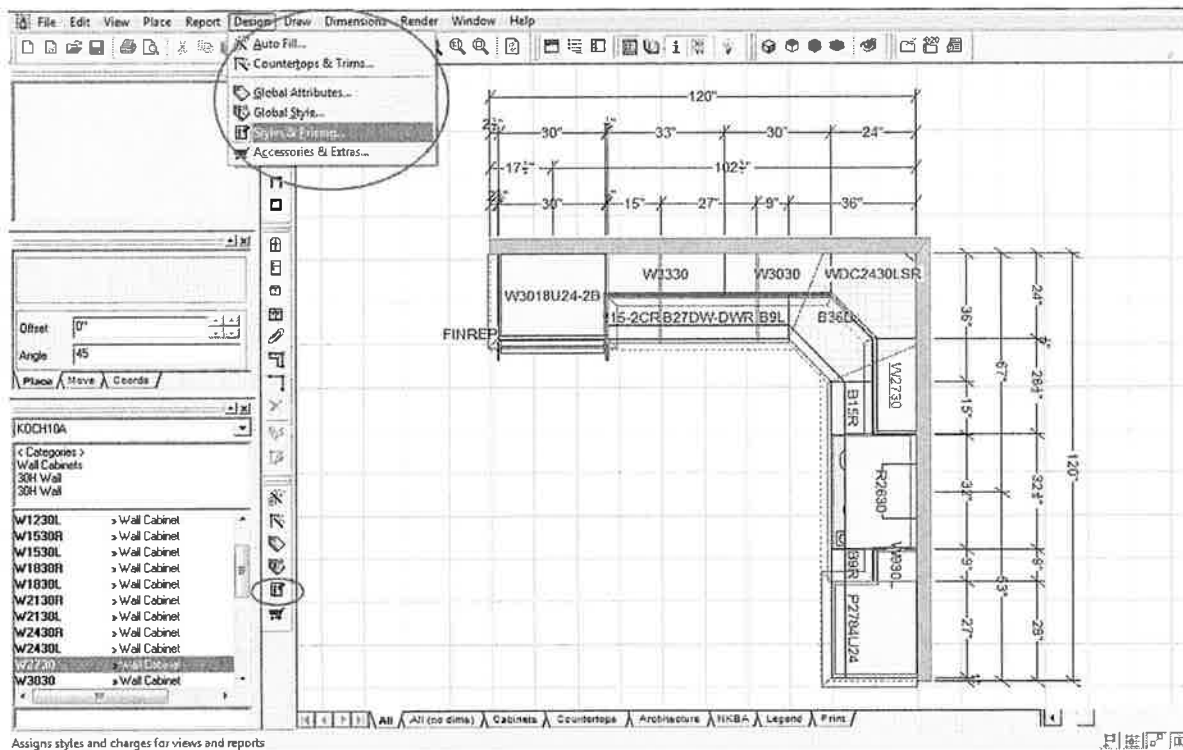


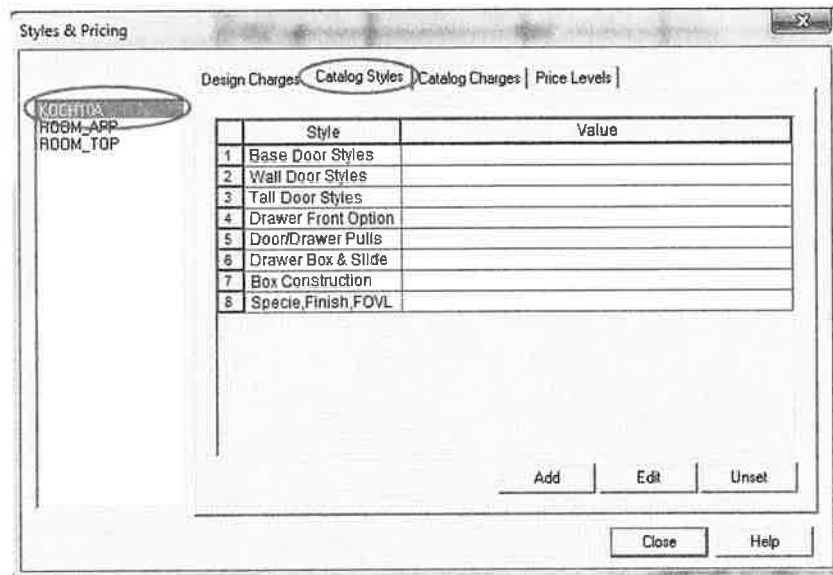
Using the 20-20 Import Tool in Cab Connect

The 20-20 import tool allows the user to import information from a design created in the 20-20 program into Cab Connect, giving the user the ability to place the order via Cab Connect.

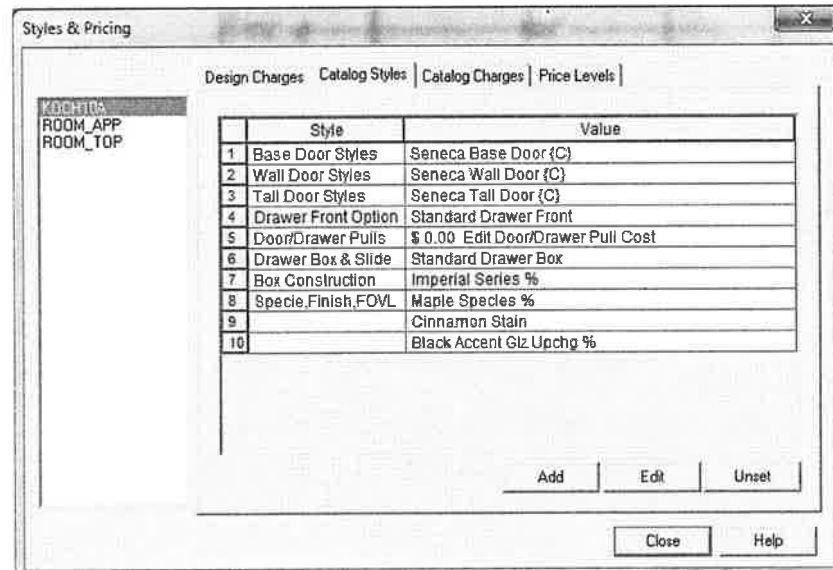
1. Once a design has been created in 20-20, set the Styles and Pricing for the design:
 - Access the Styles and Pricing module by clicking on the Styles and Pricing icon or by selecting “Styles and Pricing” from the Design menu at the top of the screen.



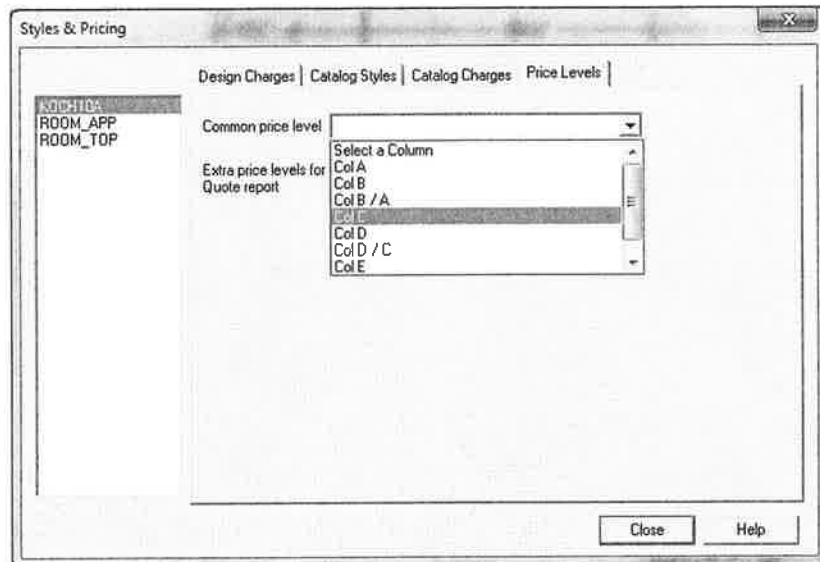
- With the appropriate catalog selected in the window at the left of the module, click on the Catalog Styles tab.



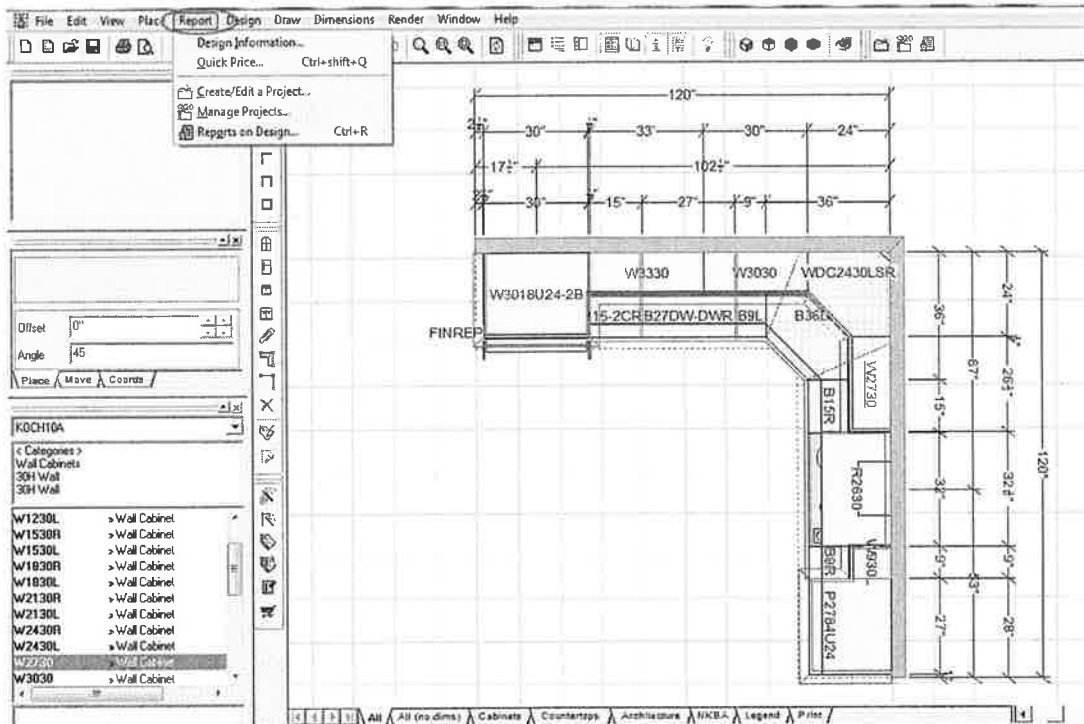
- Make a selection for each style option category.



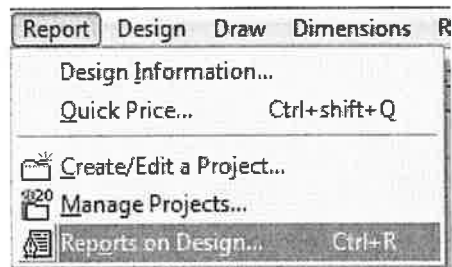
- Choose the corresponding price level from the drop down menu on the Price Level tab.



- Click Close
2. Create a TTX export file using 20-20. The TTX export file will contain the information to be imported into Cab Connect:
 - Begin by clicking on the Project menu at the top of the screen.



- From the menu, select Reports on Design. This will open the Reports on Design module.



- Highlight the "Quote" selection from the list of reports. Click OK.

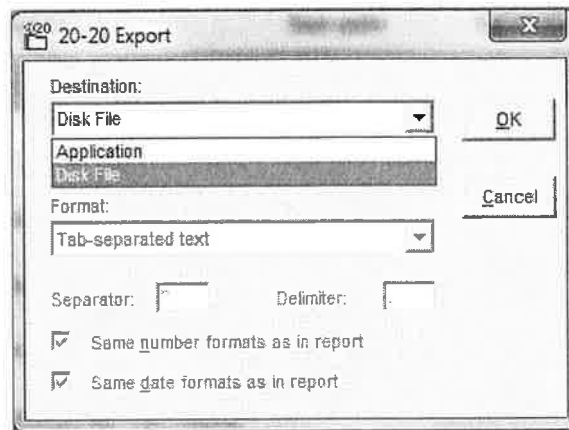

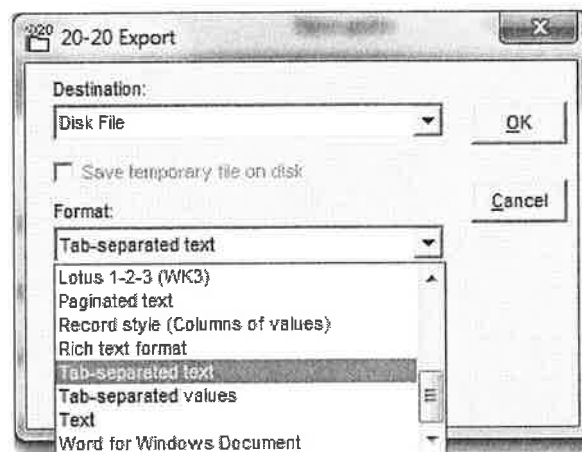

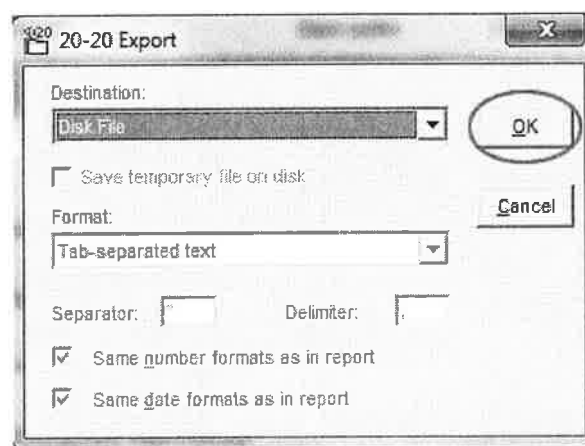
- In the 20-20 Export, click on the Destination drop down menu and select “Disk File.”



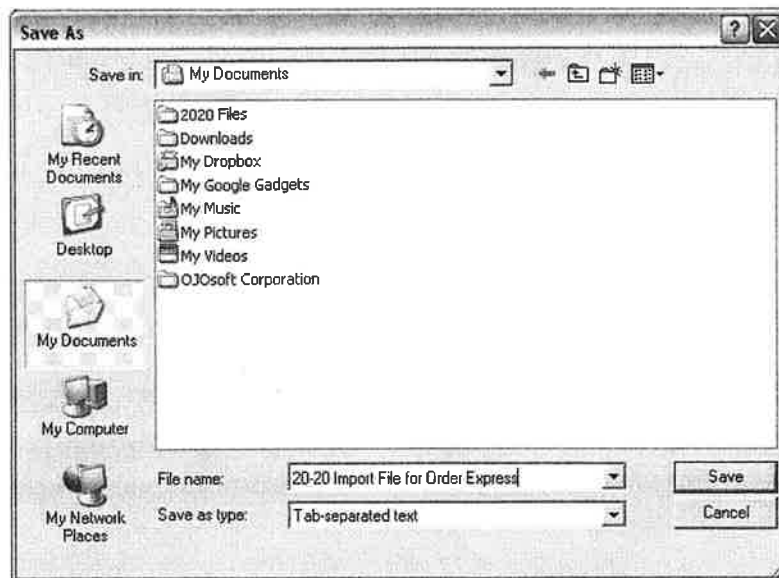
- From the Format drop down, select “Tab-separated Text.”



- Click OK.



- In the Save As window, use the Save In drop down to select the location to which the export file will be saved.



- In the File Name field, enter a name for the file.
 - Click Save.
 - Click Close on the 20-20 Report Viewer to exit.
3. Once the TTX export file has been created, it is ready to be imported into Cab Connect.
